

## Who to call?

Essex Police are committed to ensuring that their services are accessible to you and responsive to both the individual and communities needs.

You can contact Essex Police via any of the following means:

### IN AN EMERGENCY

**999**

If it is a genuine emergency always call 999 straight away

### NON-EMERGENCY

**0300 333 4444**

#### **Non-Emergency Number**

It is a 24 hour, 7 days a week service that will connect callers from across the county to the switchboard at Essex Police. Calls will then be directed to the most appropriate person, department or station.

**The non-emergency number should be used for all enquiries to Essex Police but does not replace the emergency number 999**

## Community Policing Teams

Essex Police mobile phone numbers are provided so that you can speak to your local community officers about local issues, not for reporting crimes and incidents, which must continue to be reported via 999 (emergency) or 0300 333 4444 (non-emergency):

*“Acting in a manner that causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more persons not of the same household as the perpetrator”*

- Dog Fowling
- Abandoned or Untaxed Cars
- Mini Motos
- Graffiti

## How do I report Anti-Social Behaviour?

- You will be asked for your postcode
- You will then be connected to your local Anti-Social Behaviour Team
- We would like to hear details of your problem
- We will then deal with your enquiry or make a referral to an appropriate agency/service
- You will be given feedback within 7-10 working days

The Tendring Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership is committed to tackling Anti-Social Behaviour. There are various options available, from simple intervention to stronger action:

- **Mediation**
- **Warning Letters**
- **Fixed Penalty Notices**
- **Acceptable Behaviour Contracts**
- **Anti-Social Behaviour Order**

Calling Tendring's Anti-Social Behaviour Reporting Line will enable the issue to be dealt with quicker and more effectively.
